

Outdoor Visitation Process

Pre-arranged times will be scheduled and maintained through the activity director.

All visits must be scheduled in advance using limited visiting hours and not to exceed one (1) scheduled visit per day. Visit availability will be based on staff availability for supervision of visits.

The number of visitors will not exceed 2 visitors at a time. Children may visit if they are able to maintain social distancing and wear a face mask. Each visit will be limited to 30 minutes with a minimum of 30 minutes between each scheduled visit.

Families will be asked to wait in their vehicles until the scheduled visitation time to avoid overlap with previous visitations

All visitors will be required to complete the COVID screening assessment form and the form must be approved by the visit supervisor prior to entrance to the visitation areas

- Once the visitor has successfully completed the screening assessment, the visitor will be screened for a temperature reading
 - ❖ Any person registering a reading of 100.4 degrees F will be denied the visit

Once the pre-screening is completed visitors will be escorted through the back patio gate to the designated seating area. A minimum of 6 feet will be maintained between the visitor and the resident via a single table that is 6 feet in length that meets the 6 foot requirement for safe distancing.

All parties will wear face masks unless deemed unsafe to do so

- The facility will provide masks to the residents and the visitation supervisor
- Visitors are required to provide his/her own face mask

All parties are required to perform hand hygiene prior to entering the visitation area. The facility will be responsible for providing alcohol hand gel.

Visitors will be instructed not to make physical contact with the resident and that they must maintain a 6 foot distance. If the supervising staff member observes a breach of this protocol, the visit will be terminated immediately and no further visits by that visitor will be allowed for the duration of the pandemic.
